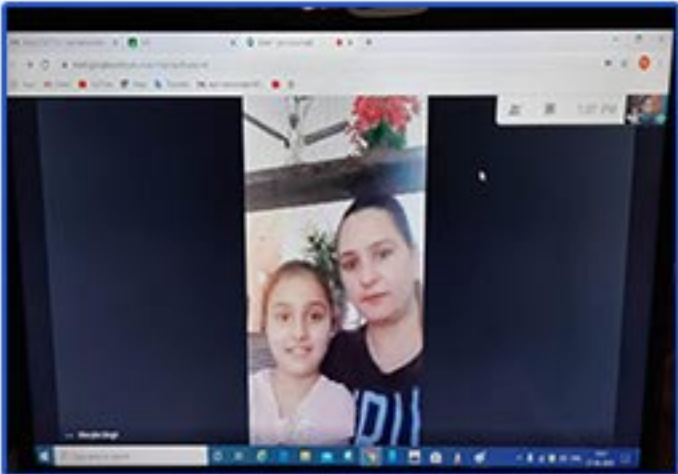
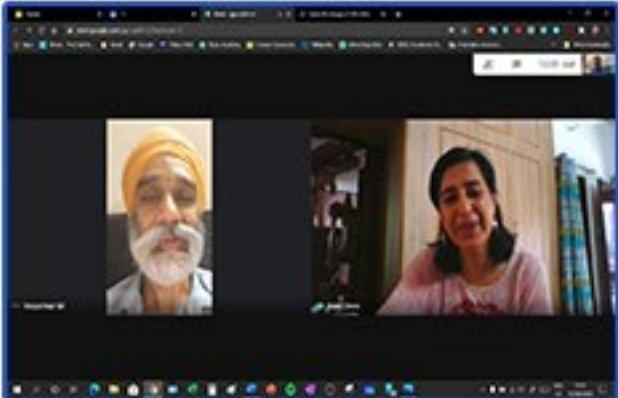
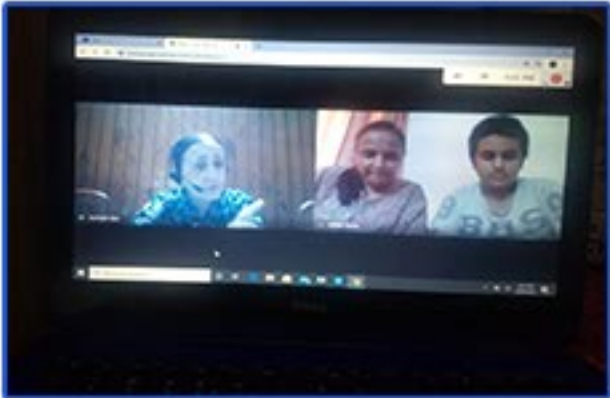
### ***First of its kind- Online PTM***

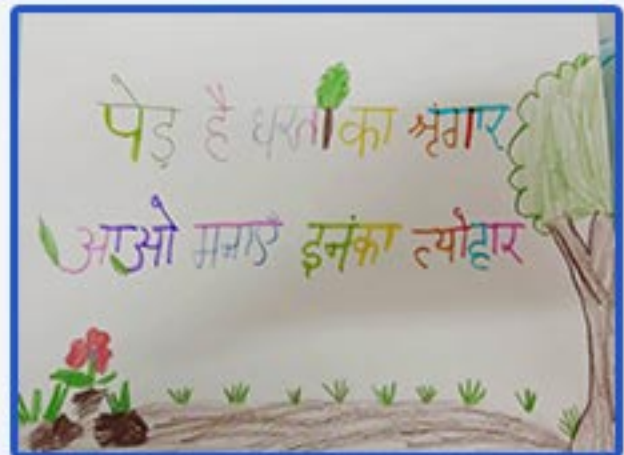

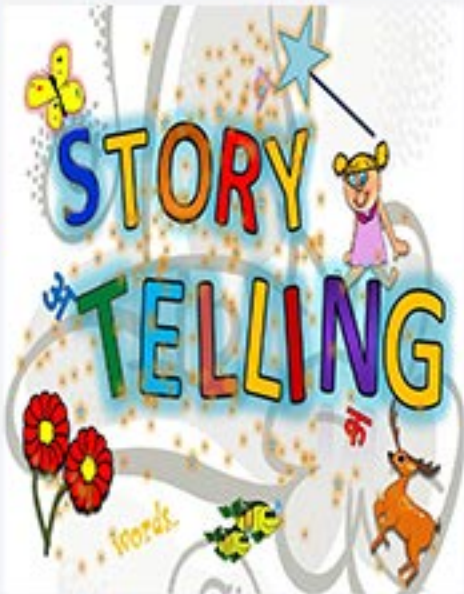
