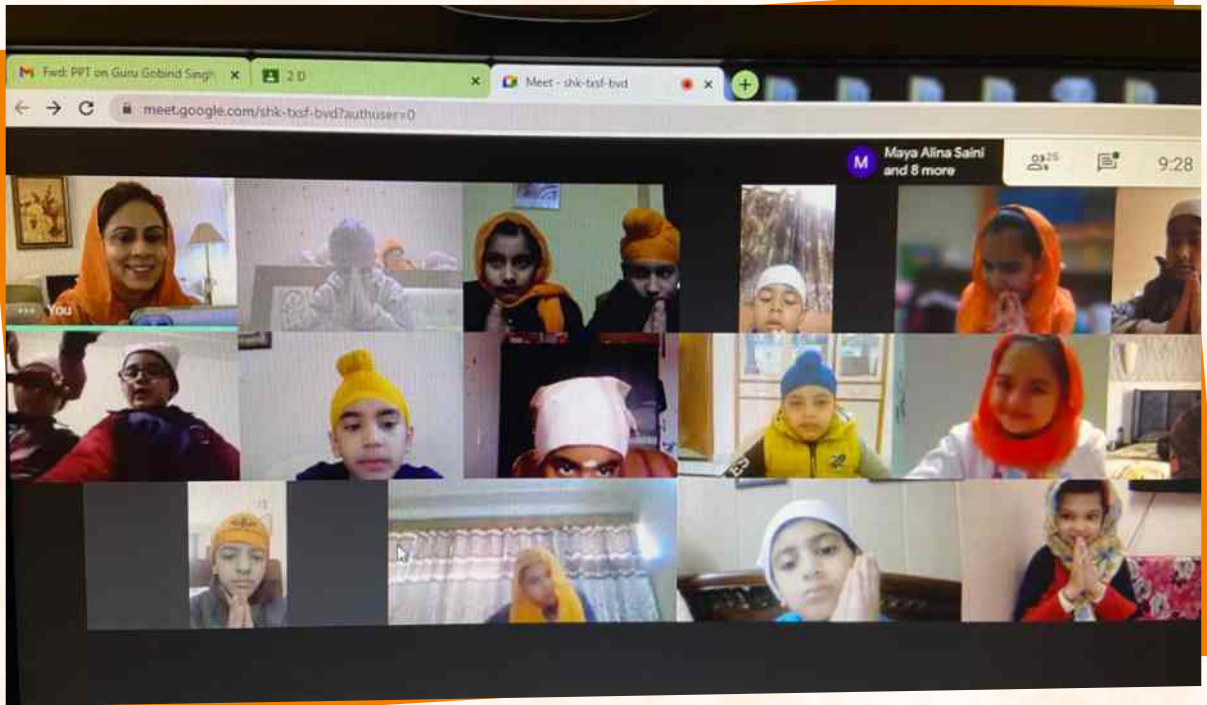

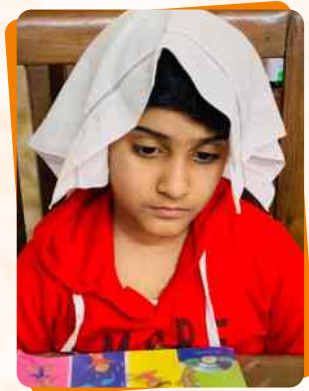

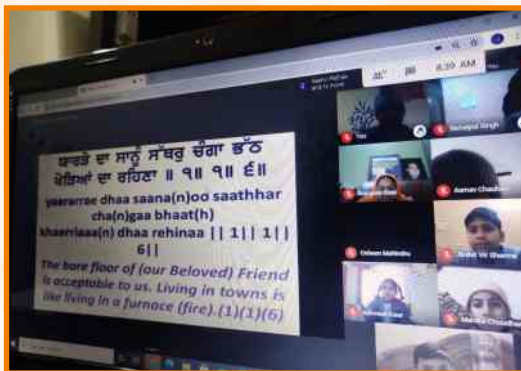
Assembly- Gurburab



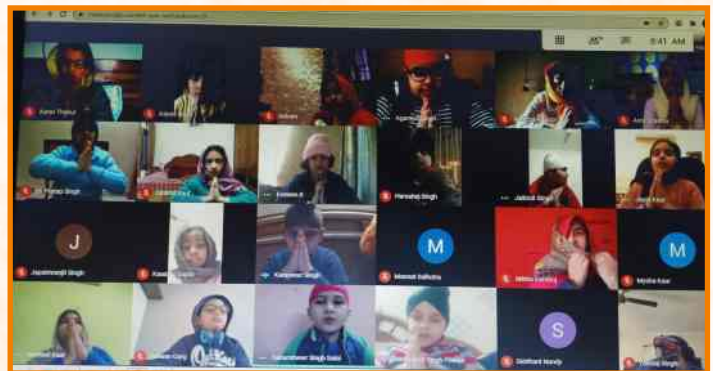
An assembly was conducted to mark the occasion of Guru Gobind Singh's Jayanti on the 19th of January in Classes 3 to 5.

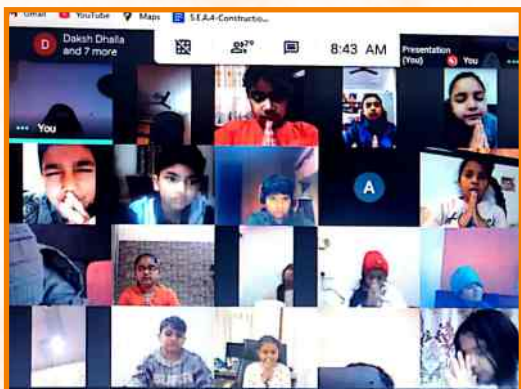
The assembly was concluded by playing a shabad which brought about serenity and peace, an apt start of the day.

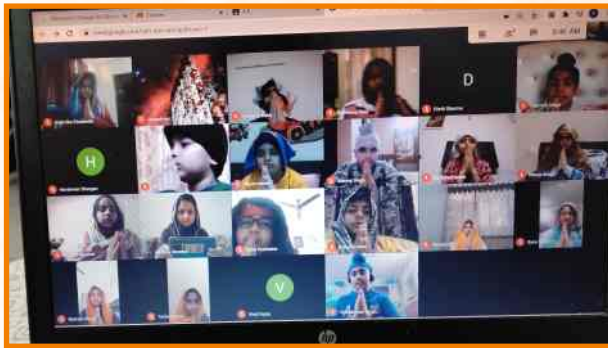

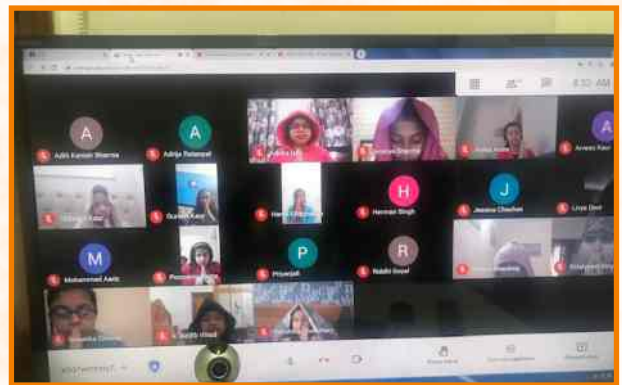

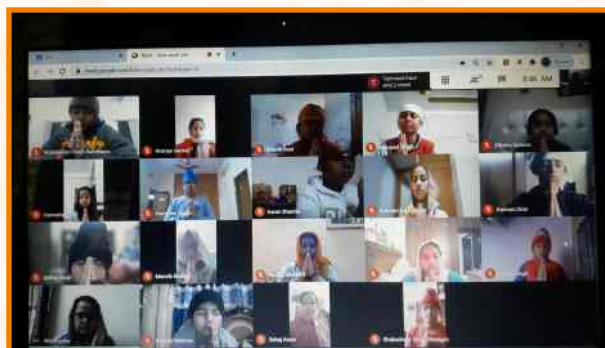

EVS Projects



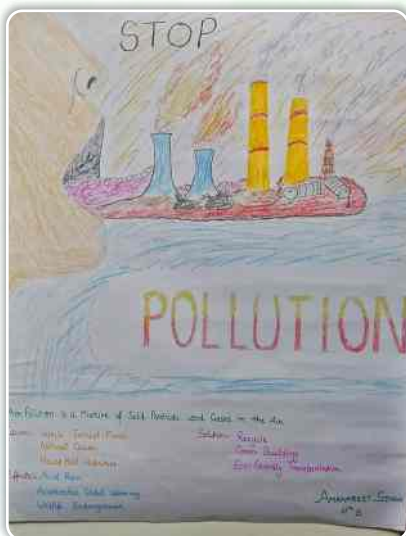
Pollution free is the way to be!

Students of Class 4 were asked to create posters on Pollution as a project in EVS to make students aware about it and suggest possible solutions.

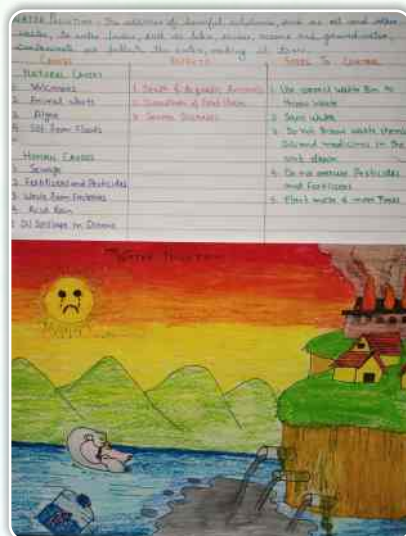
The students of Class 4 created innovative posters as a part of this assignment.

Students were very creative in their approach and created some extraordinary pieces. Not just that they also came up with innovative solutions to tackle this problem.

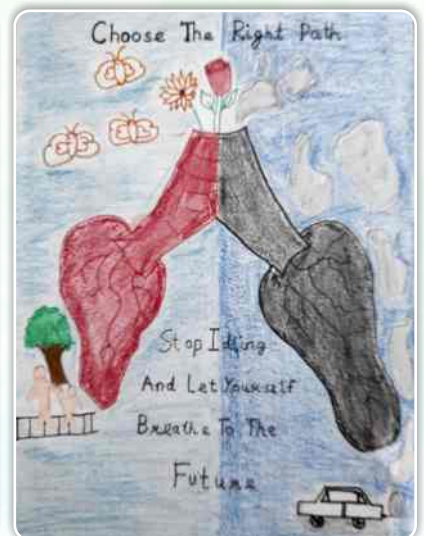
It was heartening to see that the students of the 21st century were aware of this menace and far ahead in finding solutions to this problem aiming at a Pollution- free Planet.
