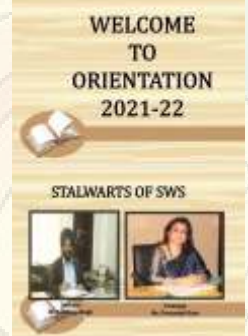
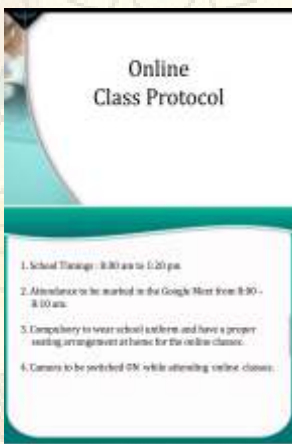


Class Orientation Programme

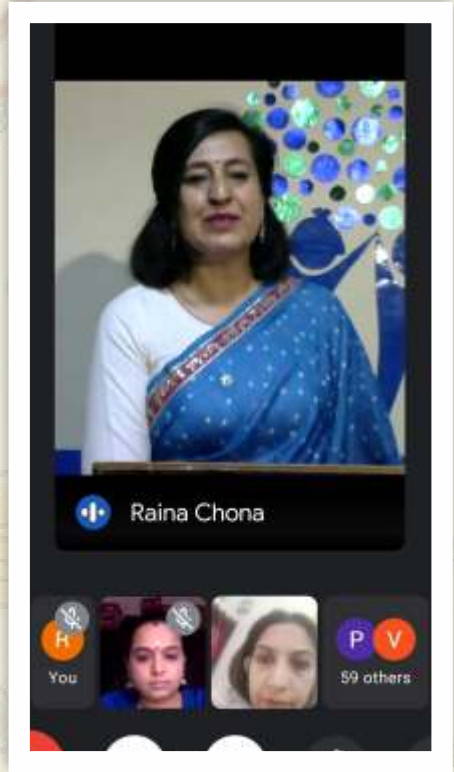
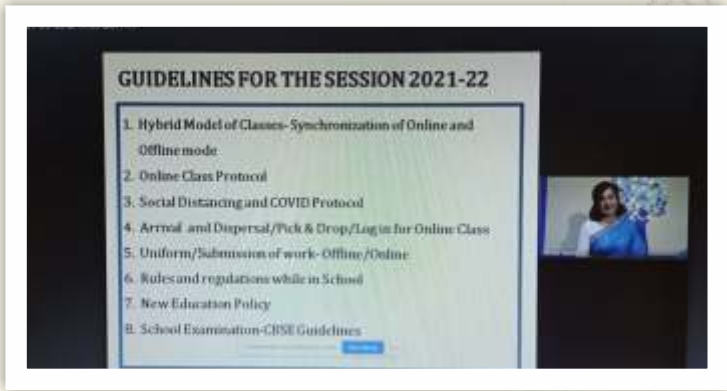
