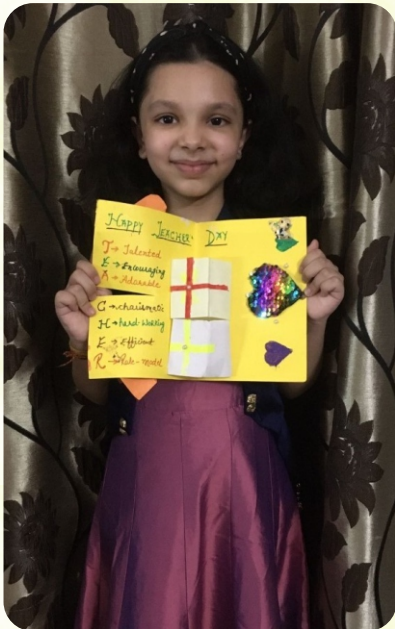
Teachers' Day

There was a buzz in the school which had been missing for a long time!



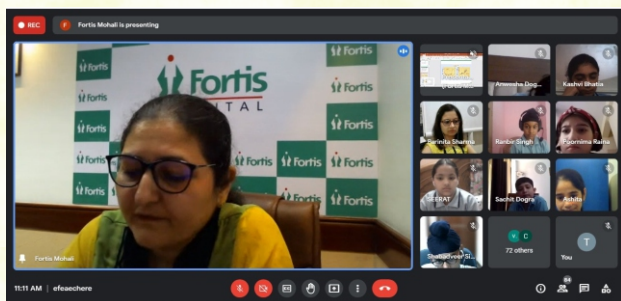
Well-being Webinar



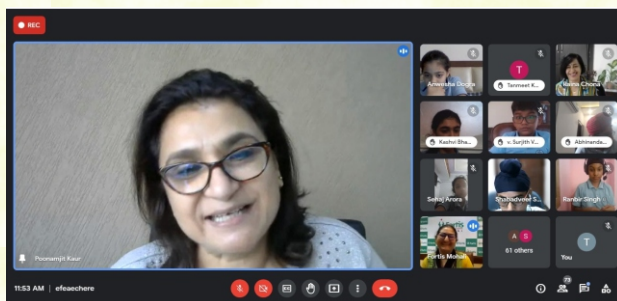
Physical and Mental Well-being webinar

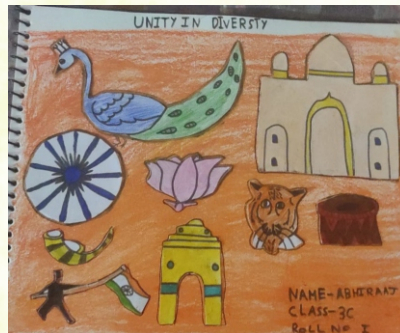
CBSE Expression Series



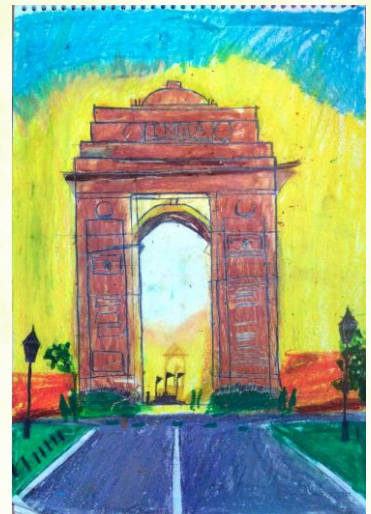

Students of Class 2 performed an activity on patterns in the Mathematics class. Patterns are formed by geometric shapes which are typically repeated.

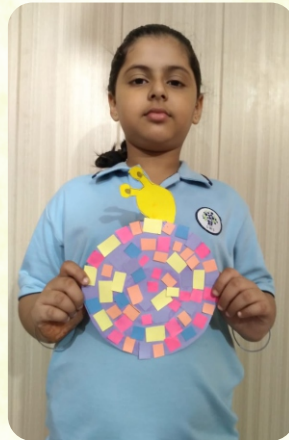
