

To share various strategies to deal with 'Examination Stress', the teachers of classes 3 to 5 presented a puppet show for the students. She told them how stress could affect their physical and mental well-being, besides ruining their year-long hard work. Students were given tips on how beautifully they can execute their exams without any undue stress, and yet come out with flying colours.




An Activity on Fractions
