## CBSE Class 10 Board Examination

### Stellar Performance by Smart Wonderites

The Management and Principal of Smart Wonders School is proud to announce the excellent CBSE Board result achieved by the Class 10 batch of 2022-23. A total of 82 students appeared for the exams, with 29 students scoring more than 90% marks.

Kanavjeet Godara is the topper of the school with 97.4%, followed by Avanya Narang in the Second position with 97.2% and Harnoor Kaur is Third with 97%. Other students who scored more than 95% are Mehul Kumar 96.4%, Bhavya Gupta 95.6% and Anavi Mehta 95.2%.

The subject toppers are Kanavjeet Godara and Mehul Kumar who successfully scored 100% in Mathematics, while Harnoor Kaur got a perfect score in French. In English, Japji Bamra scored 99 out of 100, Brahmleen Atwal and Avishi Agarwal scored 99% in Social Science, Kanavjeet Godara and Avanya Narang got 97% in Science, Avanya scored 97% in Hindi and Madhav was the highest scorer in Punjabi with 95% marks.

Congratulating the entire batch, Principal, Ms. Poonamjit Kaur said that the hard work and diligence of the students has finally paid off, and that the entire management and staff at SWS is extremely proud of their achievements. Vice Principal, Ms. Raina Chona also expressed her joy and pride, and wished the students good luck for all their future endeavours.

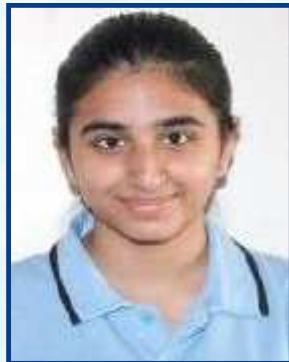

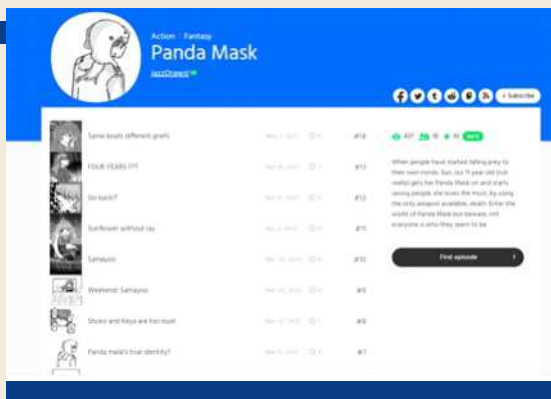


**The Young Entrepreneur (TYE) Program**
