



I Teacher's Corner

FAMILY ENGAGEMENT IN A STUDENT'S LIFE AND THE ROLE OF AN EDUCATOR



Family engagement is no longer considered a supplemental, **nice-to-have** aspect of a school's operations. It is increasingly recognized as an integral, **need-to-have** element for proficient practice as an educator. Family engagement works best when it's seen as a shared responsibility, a partnership between home and school; when it happens throughout a child's lifespan, from cradle to career; and when it occurs in all places and spaces; at home, at school, and in the community.



It is a commitment and a shared responsibility amongst all the stakeholders in a child's life. Parental engagement is directly related to the growth of the child, both at the elementary and secondary school level. The more we focus on this partnership and collaboration, the greater and deeper the impact. We empower parents with specific actionable things which they can do to support their ward's achievement. Schools that engage families; find that their students have higher grades, are more fit both physically and mentally, and attend school more regularly.

There are multiple ways in which parents can and must get involved and contribute in their ward's life

- Discussing interests and studies; acknowledging their ideas, and accepting their strengths and weaknesses.
- Doing tasks together; like shopping, vacations, movies, sports, meals, etc.
- Supervising the child's behaviour; issues and various challenges in his/her life.
- Supervising academic work; School-Initiated Contacts (PTM) about Academic performance.
- Knowing what courses and subjects; a child can take.
- Parent-School contacts on Post-Secondary plans volunteering at school and attending school activities.
- Learning about Post-Secondary Education.
- Taking part in parent organizations; communicating parent-to-parent.

Role of educators in building and strengthening the relationship

- We as educators; must recognize that all parents; regardless of income, educational, or cultural backgrounds; must be involved in their ward's learning design programs since it will support families to guide their ward's learning, from pre-school through Senior Secondary School.
- We must invite families to share their concerns and feedback.
- We must bring families into the decision-making process.
- We must offer flexibility and a variety of options for family involvement.

In a nutshell, family engagement is not just spending "Time" but "Quality Time". It is where all adults in a child's life are actively engaged in the child's overall development, the benefits of which will be reaped by not only the family, but by the society, nation, and the world at large.
