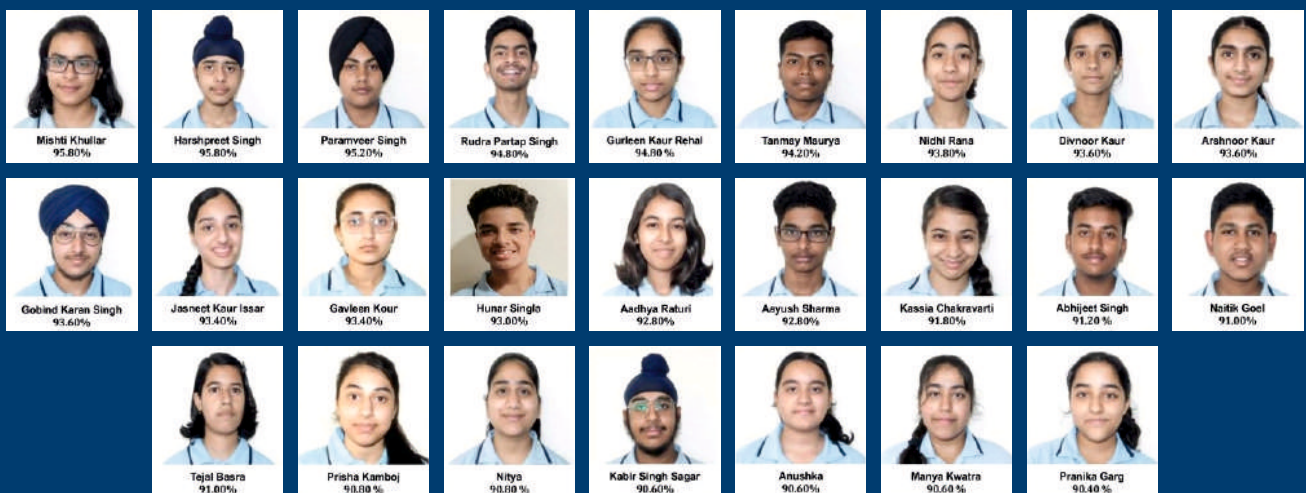
## THE SMART WONDERS HALL OF FAME

# THE CURRICULUM AT SWS

The curriculum at Smart Wonders School has been dynamically aligned to the National Education Policy 2020. The aim of the curriculum is to encourage the children to be academically inquisitive, take responsibility for their own learning and develop core skills to grow and be successful in life.

The school follows the CBSE curriculum. It has a highly researched, structured and well-planned curriculum for the students mapped to the learning needs and learning capacity of their particular age groups.



**Foundation Years (UKG-2)** follow an experiential and activity-based learning approach. **Primary Years (Classes 3-5)** focus on hands-on learning, aligning it with integration of subjects and independent expression. **Senior Wing (Classes 6-10)** aims at preparing the students for application of learning and instill rigour for taking the boards and carve a successful career.

## The SWS curriculum promotes three aspects of achievement in the student:

- The ability to express their ideas verbally and in written expression.
- The ability to apply knowledge for analysing and problem solving, as well as creating new ideas.
- The development of personal and social skills, such as introspection, confidence, competence, empathetic attitude, reflection, cooperation, coordination as well as leadership.



The curriculum encourages integration of subjects and experiential learning. The students get numerous opportunities to explore, experiment, observe and experience various concepts and skills in school. These active learning strategies provide ample opportunities to the children to learn concepts at their own pace .





# SWS ACADEMIC PROGRAMME

## JUNIOR WING

Class UKG-5

### Foundation Years

#### Class UKG - 2

The curriculum in the Foundation Years has been created to develop love for learning in the young students. Our goal is to encourage students to ask questions and develop an inquisitive mind.

**There are 6 Domains of Development which are focused on in the Foundation Years.**

- Language Development to enable effective communication verbally and in writing.
- Numeracy Development to enable problem solving, logical thinking and reasoning.
- Cognitive Development to enable intellectual curiosity, inquisitiveness and conceptual understanding.
- Physical Development to enable strong foundation for fine and gross motor skills.
- Creative Development to enable aesthetic appreciation and performance in music, dance & art.
- Social and Emotional Development to enable social competence and emotional well-being.



### Primary Years

#### Classes 3-5

The curriculum evolves to keep pace with the developing skill set, as the students grow and their understanding of the world around them develops.

- The curriculum for Primary Years is structured to provide the students with varied and challenging learning experiences to help them develop lively inquisitive minds, be creative and expand their intellectual capacities. The school aims to provide its students with a solid foundation in Literacy, Numeracy and ICT skills, Art, Music and Dance in these years. The academic knowledge helps achieve the goal of a well- balanced individual in these crucial years.
- The subject base of the students increases and includes learning the French language along with the compulsory third language of Punjabi. The subject of Environmental Science (EVS) covers scientific concepts as well as awareness about the environment.
- Conversations around topics of gender equality, empathy, religious tolerance helps in building the moral character of the children in these years. The school aims to encourage these young minds to have good inter-personal relations and take responsibility for their own actions.
- Competing with oneself and then with one's peers is taught and practiced in these wonderful growing years. The journey from young children to thoughtful adults is supported by regular and guided counselling sessions by the School Counsellor. In these impressionable years the students and teachers strive towards the motto of, "Be the best version of you" in and out of the school.



# SWS ACADEMIC PROGRAMME

## SENIOR WING Classes 6-10

The Senior Wing at Smart Wonders School has a highly researched teaching and learning methodology. Based strictly on the CBSE guidelines for teaching and assessment, the senior school aims to scaffold the growth of students into independent thinkers and learners.

The curriculum aims at:

- » Developing the ability to conceptualize, probe, reason and communicate efficiently and effectively
- » Developing a positive attitude towards learning and the capability to appreciate the aesthetic and cultural aspects of various events, people and places.
- » Fostering in the students a thirst for knowledge, honesty and an attitude of giving their best to every situation they come across in their lives.
- **Introduction of Skill Subjects** – The introduction of the New Education Policy by the Govt. of India has brought a revolutionary change in the education sector, shifting focus from rote learning to skill-based learning. Embracing the new initiative, we were one of the first schools in tricity to introduce skills subjects in our curriculum for the students of classes 6-10. These include Coding, Financial Literacy, Marketing, Artificial Intelligence, Mass Media and Marketing & Sales.
- The Scholastic areas of studies in the Senior Wing include Mathematics, Science and Social Studies, along with Languages which include English (compulsory First Language) Hindi, Punjabi and French (Second and optional Third Language). The school offers courses such as Physical Education, Painting, Music, Dance and IT.
- To enable the Smart Wonderites to excel in a technological and information rich environment, variety of teaching methods are used, which include teacher directed learning, student research, group projects and presentations. For interactive sessions and to lay emphasis on e-learning, the classrooms are equipped with Smart Boards.
- A wide range of assessment methods are used to assess students' learning outcomes. These may include individual research projects, group assignments, oral and visual presentations, use of technology including Power Point as well as more traditional class tests and assignments.
- To create 'CONFIDENT, COMPETENT and CARING young adults', the students are given exposure to inter-school, inter-city and global events like MUN, World Scholar's Cup, Zonal, District and State Level Sports Tournaments, ISRO conference, Olympiads, etc.
- The students' eventful journey into adolescence is supported by regular counselling sessions by the School Counsellor.

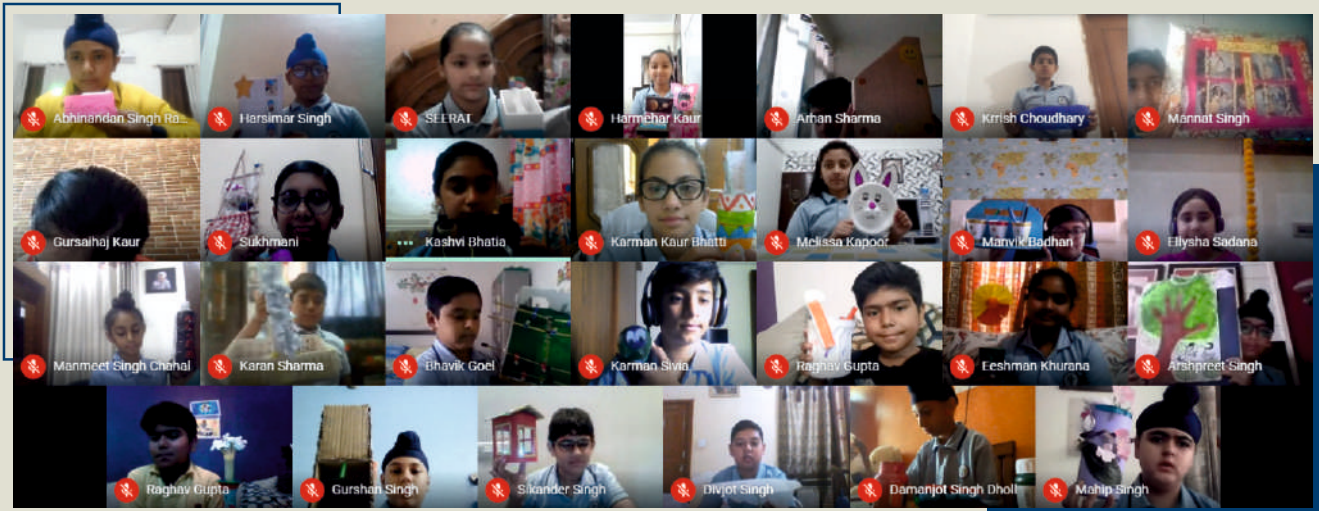

## LEARNING TOGETHER, EVEN WHEN WE WERE APART

During the pandemic, the school had successfully established an online classroom system, so that learning continued effectively. Our trained staff rose to the occasion magnificently and guided the students and their parents into a smooth transition with sensitivity and care, providing exciting and interesting activities for learning on the e-platform.

Google Meet was the educational platform used by the school for classroom teaching and other learning activities. Since April 2020, besides the teaching and learning, assemblies, competitions, parent orientation, parent-teacher meetings were conducted seamlessly using the Google Meet platform.

The alternative calendar shared by CBSE was woven into the session with thoughtful emphasis on connecting the teachers with the students and giving each one of them the space and motivation to express their own thoughts and learning. The assessment of learning using Google Forms had become an integral part of each class from class I to X. The school had successfully implemented continuous assessment programme, ensuring no break in the school calendar for the students.

Hybrid classrooms are the key for the future. The school invested time, money and human resources to ensure that all possibilities are available for the teachers and students for the seamless implementation of the new form of classroom – the hybrid classroom.

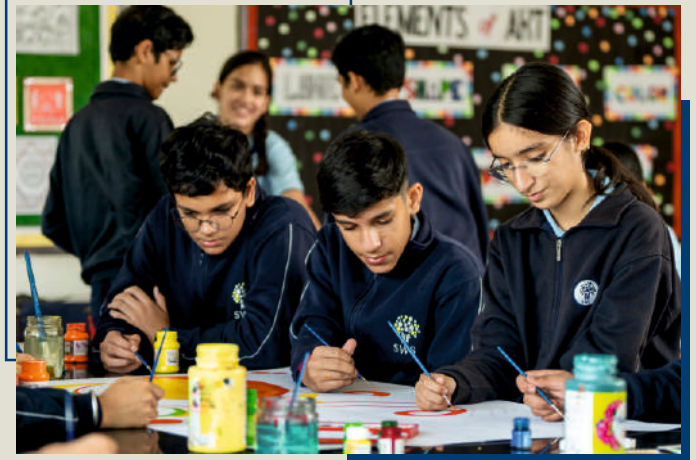
## The Learning Resource Centre

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# SCHOOL RULES & REGULATIONS

Students must come neatly dressed in their complete school uniform daily.

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Students must carry their almanac and wear the ID card to school every day .

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Students are expected to reach the school at least 5 minutes before the starting time every day. Late comers will not be allowed to enter.

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If a pupil needs to go back home urgently for any emergency during school hours, there should be a written note from the parent bearing the signature, only then the child will be handed over. Functions and outstation trips will not be treated as emergencies. The child will only be allowed to leave with the permission of the Principal.

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Medical leave will only be granted by the Principal on the provision of a medical certificate by a medical practitioner.

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Leave will be sanctioned only when applied on the Leave Application Form provided in the School Almanac.

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The affected child will not be allowed to come to school even if there is an examination.

Chicken Pox – Till complete falling of scabs.  
Cholera – Till the child is completely well.  
Measles – Two weeks after the rash disappears.  
Mumps – Until the swelling has gone.  
Whooping cough – Six weeks.

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In case of illness, the child should not be sent to school at all, even on assessment days.

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No review or examination date will be changed even if a child is absent on medical grounds.

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In all the official correspondence with the school, full name of the child, as well as the class and admission number should be mentioned.

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On all Saturdays (Except the Fourth Saturday) parents can come and meet the concerned educator, between 10:30 am - 11:30 am, after taking an appointment. Please send a diary note seeking appointment in case you would like to meet the educator on a working day after school hours.

## Birthday Celebration (UKG onwards)

We prefer to keep the birthday celebration simple to avoid any disparity or over indulgence. Parents are requested to send only 2 candies per child. Students of Classes 3 to 10 are expected to wear proper school uniform to school on birthdays.

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## General Rules

Students are not permitted to bring objectionable material to school such as magazines, video games, mobile phones, electronic gadgets, sharp objects and smart watches etc.

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Students are not permitted to wear ornaments, expensive wrist watches, apply henna, nail paint, wear fancy clips & hair bands.

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Girls with ear piercing will wear only small studs.

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Students should carry their tiffin and other articles required in school. The school staff shall not accept any item sent later during working hours due to security reasons.

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Students of Classes UKG- 5 are not allowed to carry money to buy food from the school canteen - Muffins. They need to get coupons that are to be bought by parents from the canteen.
