### Money Activity by Class 1

To teach young learners about the concept of money, a practical approach can be highly effective. Setting up a mock market provided an engaging, hands-on experience for Grade 1 students, helping them grasp basic money-related concepts such as identifying coins, notes, and bills, making transactions, and understanding value.

The primary goal of this activity was to introduce students to the basics of money through a simulated market environment. It aimed to teach them how to recognize currency, perform simple addition or subtraction, and understand the exchange process. The students brought fake currency and used it to buy items from various shops. While some students took on the role of shopkeepers, others became customers.

### Math Activity by Class 6

In this engaging math activity, students used Tangram pieces to explore the concepts of perimeter and area by creating various geometric shapes, such as squares, rectangles, and triangles. They measured the sides of the shapes and calculated the perimeter using appropriate formulas, while also determining the area by applying relevant area formulas. Through hands-on experimentation, students compared the perimeter and area of different shapes, analyzing patterns and variations. This activity not only enhanced their understanding of these key mathematical concepts but also fostered spatial reasoning and encouraged problem-solving. By collaborating in small groups, students developed communication and critical thinking skills as they shared strategies and discussed their findings, making the learning process both interactive and insightful.

### Math Activity by Class 7

The hands-on paper cutting and pasting activity to explore the area of a circle provided Class 7 students with a unique opportunity to understand mathematical concepts by combining math with art. Rather than simply memorising the formula  $A=\pi r2A = pi r^2A=\pi r^2$ , students actively engaged with the material by cutting and rearranging circles, visually connecting the area of a circle to familiar shapes like squares and triangles. This creative approach not only made abstract concepts more accessible but also fostered collaboration, critical thinking, and problem-solving, which will enhance long-term retention. By appealing to different learning styles, this activity strengthened spatial reasoning and artistic expression, helping students grasp and retain mathematical ideas in an enjoyable and engaging way.



### French Culinary Activity by Classes 4, 5 & 6


### Junior Wing's PTM<sup>+</sup>



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
