The bus will depart promptly as per schedule.• Follow instructions – Listen carefully to and follow all instructions given by teachers and trip coordinators at all times.• Stay with your group – Remain with your assigned group and teacher throughout the trip. Do not wander off alone.• Carry essentials – Bring your ID card, water bottle, packed lunch/snacks etc.• Dress appropriately – Wear your school uniform with comfortable shoes suitable for walking.• Maintain discipline – Exhibit exemplary behavior and conduct yourself responsibly as a representative of the school.• Keep the environment clean – Use dustbins for disposing of waste. Do not litter.• Stay hydrated – Drink water regularly throughout the day.• Inform immediately – Report to your teacher if you feel unwell or face any difficulty.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Do not carry valuables – Avoid bringing expensive items, jewelry, electronic gadgets etc.• Do not separate from the group – Never leave your group or designated area without permission from the teacher.• Do not misbehave – Refrain from running, pushing, shouting, or any behavior that may cause disturbance or injury in the bus.• Do not touch exhibits carelessly – Handle all exhibits and displays with care. Do not touch prohibited items.• Do not consume junk food – Eat only the food you have brought from home or from school-approved vendors on the trip.• Do not use mobile phones – Mobile phones are not allowed.• Do not litter – Do not throw waste on the ground or in unauthorized areas.• Do not enter restricted areas – Stay within permitted zones and do not venture into restricted or unauthorized areas.
