

LEAF RUBBING ACTIVITY

CREATIVE WRITING – “IF I WERE A TREE”

Class 2 participated in a creative and educational Leaf rubbing activity. This hands-on exercise not only aimed to enhance the student’s eye-hand coordination but also fostered their appreciation for nature. During the activity, each student was given a white sheet and few crayons. They were then guided to trace various shapes and patterns on the paper by rubbing it against the white sheet. The children enjoyed discovering the unique designs, imprints and patterns of the leaves appeared like magic!

This month students also took part in a fun and imaginative creative writing activity on the topic “If I Were a Tree.” In this activity, children imagined themselves as trees and wrote about what they would give to the world. They also drew colourful pictures of trees and decorated their work. This activity helped students learn the importance of trees and encouraged love for nature.

These engaging activities served multiple purposes. It allowed the students to explore their artistic skills while developing fine motor skills. Moreover, it tied into the broader theme of Van Mahotsav, encouraging the young learners to connect with and respect the natural world around them. The Leaf Rubbing activity was a delightful and enriching experience, leaving the students with a greater sense of creativity and environmental awareness.





MATH ADDITION WITH DIENE'S BLOCK

A hands-on Math activity was conducted in Grade 1 to help students understand addition without regrouping using Dienes blocks. Children used tens rods and ones cubes to build numbers and visually added them together. This concrete method helped them clearly see how numbers combine without crossing over to the next place value. They enjoyed placing the blocks and counting the total. The activity made the abstract concept of addition simple and meaningful. It also encouraged active participation and peer learning. Students were excited and confident while solving sums using the blocks





HINDI "ई" MATRA

A fun-filled Hindi activity was conducted in Grade 1 to introduce the बड़ी ई की मात्रा. Students first drew the matra (ई) using a pencil, learning its correct formation. Then, they decorated it by pasting pulses over their drawn matra. This hands-on approach helped them understand the shape and structure of the matra in a creative way. The activity not only supported matra recognition but also improved their fine motor skills. Children thoroughly enjoyed the experience and participated with excitement and focus.






रचनात्मक लेखन और छाता सजाने की गतिविधि




CREATIVITY AT IT'S BEST (2D SHAPES)








HOLIDAY HOMEWORK TREASURE

MOVIE SCREENING PROMOTES INCLUSION AND EMPATHY



Displaying excellent skill and team spirit, Riddhi's team performed commendably and won the bronze medal by defeating the opponent team.


